Ban on Outdoor Burning - LIFTED

August 23rd, 2022

As of today, the ban on all outdoor burning within the City of Reno and the City of Sanctuary **has been temporarily lifted.** The lifting of this Outdoor Burning Ban will remain lifted unless drought conditions deteriorate; the Fire Chief or Fire Marshal has the authority to retract the lifting of the burn ban. We request that all citizens follow the guidelines set forth by each community for burning.

- *Sanctuary residents please contact the Tarrant County Fire Alarm center to notify them of your burn.*
